

## GUIDELINES FOR "Celebration of Quilts" QUILT SHOW

All guild members are encouraged to enter quilts and other items in the quilt show as well as items for the guild boutique. Guild keeps 10%.

Entries **cannot** have been previously shown in any "Celebration of Quilts" show.

You may enter quilts, pillows, table runners, clothing, tote bags, etc...Don't be shy even if you are a beginning quilter.

Enter as many quilts as you wish, but understand that there might be space limitations, and we might have to limit certain numbers of quilt sizes.

**Number** your entries on the **lower right corner of your registration** form in order of preference.

**Photocopy** the attached registration form. There must be **one entry for each item**, with the exception of a set of placemats or pillows.

**Accurate measurements** are necessary to the logistics committee.

**Photographs** are very important for a number of reasons. They help with security, identification, your household insurance (should something happen), and in hanging plans for the show. Guild challenges included. **We require colour photos.** Items photographed on a bed or draped on a chair can NOT be used to ID a lost quilt.

**Deadline** for submission of entries is the business meeting \_\_\_\_\_. Quilts do not have to be finished by this date, but registration with attached photo must be handed in for deadline.

There are always new ideas and requirements so all members are strongly urged to come to the demonstration on sleeves, labels, rods and quilt storage bags. This is to ensure that you have no problems at the security check-in desk on set-up day. Rods with screw eyes should be NO wider than the quilt. All quilts must have a hanging sleeve, a label, and a wood slat with screw eyes for hanging. We will have examples at the demo night.
